**Confirmation:** The Bishop is scheduled to be here December 1, 2018. Be prepared by studying the catechism. Sponsors must be traditional practicing Catholics at least 16 years old. **Confessions:** Times as listed, plus by consultation with one of the priests. Please try to come during the week if you live nearby. Be clear, complete, concise and contrite.
