SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptism: Registered faithful only. Please contact the office to arrange the date. Godparents must be practicing traditional Catholics at least 16 years old.

Confirmation: We will let you know when the Bishop will be coming. Be prepared by studying the catechism. Sponsors must be practicing traditional Catholics at least 16 years old. To enroll in Sunday Catechism program, contact Mr. Craig Wilkerson, Email: catechism@ourladyofsorrows.org

Confessions: Times as listed, plus by consultation with one of the priests. Please try to come during the week if you live nearby. Be clear, complete, concise and contrite.

Marriages: Priest needs at least six months' notice. This sacrament is only for registered faithful. Normally no weddings on Sundays.
