## SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

**Baptism:** Registered faithful only. Please contact the office to arrange the date. Godparents must be practicing traditional Catholics at least 16 years old.

**Confirmation:** We will let you know when the Bishop will be coming. Be prepared by studying the catechism. Sponsors must be practicing traditional Catholics at least 16 years old. **Confessions:** Times as listed, plus by consultation with one of the priests. Please try to come during the week if you live nearby. Be clear, complete, concise and contrite.

**Marriages:** Priest needs at least six months' notice. This sacrament is only for registered faithful. Normally no weddings on Sundays.
