

Requiescant in pace. Amen.

Eternal rest grant to them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen

## Six general rules for obtaining a plenary indulgence:

- 1. State of grace.
- 2. Complete detachment from sin, even venial sin.
- 3. Confession (8 days before or after the indulgenced act).
- 4. Communion (8 days before or after the indulgenced act).
- 5. Prayers for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff.
- 6. Indulgenced act: a special good work with special conditions of place and time.
