Ladies and girls please wear a **head-covering** and a dress that goes well below the knees when sitting. Men and boys please do not wear sports clothes or athletic shoes at Sunday Mass

## Sacramental information:

**Baptism:** Registered faithful only. Please contact the office to arrange the date. Normally no baptisms on Sundays. Godparents must be traditional practicing Catholics at least 16 years old.

**Confirmation:** We will let you know when the Bishop will be coming. Be prepared by studying the catechism. Sponsors must be traditional practicing Catholics at least 16 years old. **Confessions:** Times as listed, plus by consultation with one of the priests. Please try to come during the week if you live nearby. Be clear, complete, concise and contrite.

**Marriages:** Priest needs at least six months notice. This sacrament is only for those who registered faithful. Normally no weddings on Sundays.
