Sacramental information:

Baptism: Registered faithful only. Please contact the office to arrange the date. Normally no baptisms on Sundays. Godparents must be traditional practicing Catholics at least 16 years old.

Confirmation: Scheduled for Saturday, February 16, 2019. Be prepared by studying the catechism. Sponsors must be traditional practicing Catholics at least 16 years old. To enroll in Sunday program; see Mr. Michael Rayes via office. Email: catechism@ourladyofsorrows.org

Confessions: Times as listed, plus by consultation with one of the priests. Please try to come during the week if you live nearby. Be clear, complete, concise and contrite.

Marriages: Priest needs at least six months notice. This sacrament is only for those who registered faithful. Normally no weddings on Sundays.
